B. HOUSEHOLD INFORMATION

In the table below, list the people in your parents' household. Write the names of all household members, ages, relationship, and college they will attend. Include only those individuals who receive more than half of their support through your parents during the period from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. FAFSA also requires students to report any financial contributions received from members of the household, *besides contributions from parents*, if the financial contributions were used for household expenses. - a. yourself
- b. your parents (or stepparents)
- c. siblings or other children that your parents provide more than 50% of their support for, even if the sibling or child does not live with your parents

- e. college that any household member, excluding parents, attends at least half-time (6 credit hours)
- f. financial support contributed to the household **per month** (if nothing was contributed, or if parents' income is already included on the FAFSA, *you must enter 0 or n/a*; if a blank is left, the form will be incomplete)

C. STUDENT TAX INFORMATION

Remember the easiest and most accurate way to provide income information is by using the IRS Data Exchange that is a part of the student's FAFSA online. If the student/parent has not already used the tool, please log on to their 2026-27 FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov and select "Make FAFSA Corrections". Select the "Financial Information" tab and follow the instructions to see if the student/parent is eligible to use the Data Exchange tool. If the student is eligible, follow each step to transfer their 2023 tax information into the student's FAFSA.
